PASTORAL PONDERINGS

"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me." ~ Psalm 51:10-12

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of Lent, a time of atonement—of working to repair our past wrongs. It is time spent in self-reflection about our beliefs, our actions, and our responses to others' actions.

This year we will be taking a look at how we fit into the picture of Holy Week. Each Sunday, we will carefully examine what is happening within each day of Jesus' last week, and look for where we find ourselves within that picture. We will also have a study on Wednesday mornings based on the book "Entering the Passion of Jesus" by Amy -Jill Levine (who inspired this series).

Levine suggests that Lent is a time for us to be asking the hard questions: what should I have done that I did not do? What risk should I have taken that I was afraid to take? When did my sense of self-preservation trump my sense of courage? She goes on to say that "the Passion narrative asks much of us, and it also gives us the knowledge that we can do what we are asked, and the assurance that we will succeed."(1)

These are challenging questions, because they make us vulnerable, and nobody likes to be vulnerable. We don't like to admit we were wrong, or that our actions hurt ourselves or someone else. But we are human, which means we are not perfect, and we need to take time to allow God to shine God's light in those areas of our lives that are shadowed.

This Lent, join us for worship, or Bible Study, or Soup and Discussion, or any combination of these times. Take a deep breath, and allow yourself to be open to what God wants for you, and of you, then allow God to clean out those areas, and create in you a new and right heart.

Throughout each camp you will experience an awakening of your spirit to renew a sense of joy and wonder of fellowship and nature.






