**PASTORAL PONDERINGS**

*“I will praise God’s name in song and glorify God with thanksgiving.” ~ Psalm 69:30*

I am sitting at my desk, watching the rain fall gently outside. The first rain in.... I don’t have any idea how long. While it looks dreary, and is most definitely cooler than it has been the last several days, I am thanking God for what we are receiving. It might not be enough to quench the thirsty earth completely, but at least it is whetting it a little.

October is winding down way faster than I was anticipating, and November is literally right around the corner. For me, November is the month of Thanks. Granted, I am thankful all of the time, and don’t need a specific month to give thanks in, but it is a good reminder. And this year, I have SO much to be thankful for!

I am thankful for health, and family, and friends, and a new puppy, and the earth, and a roof over my head, and food in my stomach, and my call to Faith, and all of you, and.....and.....and.....and I don’t know where to stop.

I know how blessed I am. I know that in our culture today, I am privileged. I have things that so many others do not. Not just material things, but life giving things—the food, the shelter, the access to healthcare, my boys’ access to education, and so much more. And that makes me even more thankful.

But what good is being thankful, if all you do is say “thank you?” While that is definitely important, so is living like you are thankful. When we choose to live out our thanksgiving in our every day lives, things happen. We are less stressed, we have greater peace, and more joy. We feel better about ourselves and are more open to ideas of others.

Being thankful may seem simple, but sometimes it isn’t. Sometimes, in reality, often times, we take things for granted. We believe they will always be there, whether it is material, or creation, or a relationship. We forget to take a brief moment to give those around us thanks, as well as give God thanks.

I officiated the funeral of an 18 year old yesterday. It was one of the hardest funerals I have had to do yet. As I watched friends and family gather at the funeral home, including his girlfriend and 6 week old son, I gave thanks for the common love shared in that room. Believe me when I say I may have been the only one who recognized it. So I said it during the service. I gave thanks to those gathered there, for their outpouring of love for the one they mourned, and for one another. I gave thanks to God for the opportunity to be reminded that there is so much in life to be thankful for.

As we move into November, I invite you to take a moment each day and say thank you to one human for something they have done, and thank you to God for one blessing you have been given. If you feel ambitious, make it three! Like every spiritual discipline, being thankful takes practice. And practice makes perfect—or at the very least, it makes us feel good.

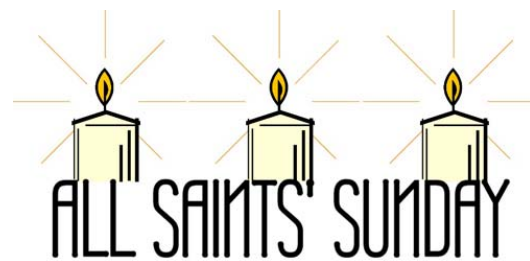
**Annual Report**
